The Best Scholarship Program in the World* (. . . and what you need to do to apply)

What is it? Rotary Foundation Ambassadorial Scholarships and Rotary Grants for University Teachers

- ◆ Up to two years of study at just about any school in the world.
- ◆ Stipend of up to \$23,000 depending upon type of scholarship.

How is it different from other scholarships?

- ◆ It's bigger than any other privately funded scholarship program in the world (close to 1000 scholarships are awarded worldwide each year)
- ◆ Scholars have a network of Rotarians to help them during their study abroad. This can be oh so valuable for everything from finding a place to stay to making your new home feel like home, or even just finding a friend for lunch.

Who is the ideal candidate?

- ◆ Excellent students with a sterling record of achievement and a strong service orientation. Students need to have a familiarity with Rotary and the Rotary mission, and how their goals fit in to that mission.

What is the application process?

1. Go www.rotary.org, follow the Students and Youth link, to learn more about Rotary scholarships and to download applications.
2. Download the appropriate application and complete it.
3. You must submit the application to a Rotary club where you are a full time student (or) your permanent place of residence. You can find the link to all clubs in Rotary District 6900 in Georgia at www.rotarydistrict6900.org. Call or send an email to a local club to inquire about a sponsorship. They will be happy to hear from you!

The DUE DATE for applicants to submit to most Rotary clubs is usually during first week of May. Please call to confirm the date that applications are due.

4. Local Rotary Clubs will review applications and **must submit them on or before June 30 to the District 6900 Scholarship Committee. This is a FIRM DEADLINE.**
5. The District Scholarship Committee will review the applications and develop an interview schedule for those applicants who will continue in the process.

Interviews will be held on August 14, 2009.

6. Shortly after the day of interviews, the District Scholarship Committee will announce the scholarship winners. **Ambassadorial Scholars chosen in August 2009 will complete their scholarship in the 2010-2011 academic year.**
